10	Los Tros Chenin Blanc, Marras Swartland, South Africa (Ve) Very drinkable pear and stone-fruited wine, complemented by crisp freshness and around mouthfeel with a refreshing finish.	£32
11	l'Inattendu Muscadet Sèvre-et-Maine, Jérémie Huchet Loire, France (Ve) The l'Inattendu has interesting complexity on the nose with dried fruits and fresh flower aromas. The palate is intense and deep, finishing on a nice fresh mineral note.	£34
12	Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine de Guillemarine Languedoc, France (Ve) Classic aromas of white flowers, stone fruit, and lemon with floral notes and a refreshing briney twist on the finish reminding you of the proximity to the sea.	£34
13	White Rabbit Riesling Rhein, Germany A multifaceted Riesling, versatile with or without food. Redolent of cut grass and herbs with notes of white blossom and tropical fruit. Balanced and beautifully refreshing.	£32
14	Pecorino Vellodoro, Umani Ronchi 2020 Abruzzo, Italy (O, Ve) A refreshing, light-to-medium-bodied Pecorino, combining tangy green apple fruit flavours with hints of herbs, stones and almonds. The lively acidity lifts the palate, giving a finish that's as clean as a whistle.	£36
15	Pulenta Estate VIII Chardonnay 2019 Mendoza, Argentina Ripe tropical fruit flavours are complemented by a fresher, citrusy element, whilst the oak gives toasted almond and coconut notes as well as texture and volume.	£36
16	Lugana Catulliano, Pratello 2020 Lombardy, Italy (Ve) Open and expressive on the nose, with notes of citrus, apple and herbs. The palate is round and apricotty, yet with a mineral tautness that provides a very elegant finish.	£37
17	BOB Short for Kate Sauvignon Blanc, Glover Family Vineyards Marlborough, New Zealand (O, Ve) This zesty Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc offers the best of what the region has to offer. Lashings of tropical passion fruit, guava and mandarin leap from the glass.	£38
18	Gavi di Gavi La Meirana, Broglia 2019 Piedmont, Italy (Ve) Great texture and precision, with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry, this is particularly characterful Gavi.	£53
19	Chablis Domaine Ste Claire, JM Brocard 2019 Burgundy, France (O, Ve) Fresh nose with light fruity aromas and elegant minerality on the palate; compared to Brocard's regular Chablis, this organic version has an extra degree of vividness and savoury complexity.	£55

24	Sauvignon Blanc, Dog Point Vineyard Marlborough, New Zealand (O, Ve) A bright, fresh, citrus-driven Sauvignon Blanc from one of Marlborough's top producers. Pure with a juicy citrus core and a backdrop of honeydew melon, pears and apples.	£48
25	Tenute Altavilla Greco di Tufo, Villa Matilde 2020 Campania, Italy The wine offers bold flavours of white peach and apricot, giving way to notes of citrus and an appealing mineral streak. The palate is rich and well-structured and the finish leaves a subtle yet lingering flavour of sweet almonds.	£46
26	Nozze d'Oro, Tasca 2018 Sicily, Italy (Ve) With apple, peach, melon and honey aromas, and a sleek, well-defined palate, this is crisp and refreshing, yet with an underlying power.	£50
27	Between Five Bells White Blend 2020 Victoria, Australia (Ve) This rich, textural wine is a seamless amalgam of four grape varieties, with pear, citrus and almond flavours riding on a generous, layered palate.	£52
28	Chablis 1er Cru Vau de Vey, Brocard 2018 Burgundy, France (O, Ve) A wine of clarity and precision, the Vau de Vey shows delicate citrus and floral aromas, as well as some smoky mineral touches. Medium-bodied and savoury on the palate, this is complex and characterful Chablis.	£68
29	Impero Blanc de Pinot Noir, Fattoria Mancini 2019 Marches, Italy Impressive and distinctive wine, showing spice from the wood and bright red apple/peach aromas. Broad structure in the mouth, not unlike a Côte de Nuits white balanced and positive, with a herbal freshness.	£71
30	Lucia Chardonnay, Pisoni 2019 California, USA (Ve) Bright flavors of green apple and lemon zest. There is a richness and power to the wine, in the form of ripe pear, apple crisp and vanilla bean notes. Together, creating a wine with exquisite balance, purity of fruit and a pillar of bright, focused acidity.	£75
31	Cervaro della Sala, Antinori 2019 Umbria, Italy Intense, complex aroma with notes of white flowers and flint balanced by a hint of vanilla. Full-bodied and well-structured palate with notes of toast, citrus and mineral. Elegant and persistent in the mouth, this is a wine with a long life ahead of it.	£105
32	Puligny 1er Cru La Truffière, Vincent Morey 2018 Burgundy, France An incredibly mineral-driven wine with a picture-perfect display of mineral intensity in white burgundy dominating the nose and accompanied by, honeysuckle, bosc pear, wild fennel and bee pollen. The palate has such a graceful attack, so elegant with perfect balance, which is very apparent on the dense limestone finish.	£135

33	Protea Merlot, Anthonij Rupert Wyne Franschoek, South Africa The Protea Merlot offers up boisterous black fruit aromatics on the nose, with hints of blueberry, cherry and undertones of chocolate. Juicy and supple.	£32
34	Pinot Noir Turitelles, Domaine d'Altugnac Languedoc, France (Ve) This Pinot Noir Turitelles with garnet-coloured juice is perfumed with fine spices (nutmeg and cinnamon), mocha and Montmorency cherry.	£34
35	Quinde Reserve Malbec, Bodegas Vinocol Mendoza, Argentina (O, Ve) Delicious Malbec with aromas of fresh plums and vanilla that lead to a full-bodied and fruit-driven palate, with a silky structure. Aged in French oak for 6 months.	£36
36	Campofiorin Ripasso, IGT Rosso del Veronese, Masi 2018 Veneto, Italy (O, Ve) Attractive, aromatic nose dominated by cherries and spice. Well-balanced, full-bodied palate with notes of ripe red fruit, cherry liqueur and blueberries. Long aftertaste with hints of vanilla and cocoa.	£38
37	Shiraz, Pitchfork Margaret River, Australia Vibrant and youthful Shiraz with ripe cherry and plum fruits on the nose and a hint of smooth chocolate. Good depth of fruit and ripe sweet fruit flavours.	£36
38	Côtes-du-Rhône Rouge Confidence, Domaine Fond Croze Rhône Valley, France (O, Ve) A classic Côtes du Rhône, full of blackberries and cassis with notes of wild herbs. A lovely spicy and velvety structure that leads to a long finish.	£38
39	Jorio Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Umani Ronchi Abruzzo, Italy (Ve) Flavours of ripe plums and red cherries give way to balsamic and savoury notes. The palate is full-bodied, with plush, velvety tannins and the finish is long and intense, with subtle notes of liquorice and spice.	£39
40	Conde Valdemar Rioja Crianza 2016 Rioja, Spain (Ve) Complex aromas of ripe black berries balanced with warm vanilla notes and a touch of subtle spice. Excellent, rounded structure on the palate with aromatic complexity lasting through to the finish.	£39
41	Château Montaguillon, Montagne-Saint-Emilion 2016 Bordeaux, France (Ve) An expressive nose of roasted plums, dried herbs and fresh earthy notes leads to a medium-full, currant-infused palate of both breadth and focus.	£44
42	Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine du Vieux Lazaret 2018 Rhône, France (Ve) A ripe, spicy blend with notes of vanilla and dark berry fruit. Full-bodied but elegant in the mouth, with a persistent juicy finish.	£68

48	Les Piliers de Maison Blanche, Montagne Saint-Émilion Bordeaux, France (B, Ve) A refined blend of Cabernet Franc and Merlot with aromas of cassis and dark berry fruits that lead to a rounded palate of supple blackberry and plum flavours with a hint of spice.	£46
49	Chianti Classico Riserva, Tenuta di Bibbiano Tuscany, Italy (O, Ve) Dark red fruit and plummy notes underpinned with Tuscan herbs. Beautifully rounded with a velvety structure and a long finish.	£52
50	Barolo, Prunotto 2017 Piedmont, Italy (Ve) Complex nose with notes of rose, strawberry and forest fruits. Delicately floral, perfumed yet persistent on the palate, this is Barolo at its best.	£75
51	Les Charmes de Kirwan, Margaux Bordeaux, France (Ve) Beautifully silky Margaux. Rich and well-balanced with lovely fresh and ripe cassis and cherry fruit that rolls over the palate in a powerful wave. Long and succulent finish.	£73
52	Aloxe-Corton, Maillard Père et Fils Burgundy, France Purity and intensity are beautifully balanced in this stunning Brunello. Bright red fruit and floral notes, silky texture and a smooth finish.	£80
53	Costasera Amarone Classico, Masi 2015 Veneto, Italy (Ve) Bright and intense on the nose with aromas of preserved cherries and dried plums together with cinnamon. Good weight from the alcohol and structured on the palate.	£80
54	Rosso di Montalcino, Pian delle Vigne, Antinori 2019 Tuscany, Italy This wine shows aromas of ripe red fruit, with floral and spicy notes adding lift and complexity. The palate is medium-bodied and succulent, with a persistent juicy freshness.	£52
55	S'arai, Pala 2015 Sardinia, Italy (Ve) Pala's flagship wine is deep, complex and exquisitely balanced. The intense ripe fruit combines with an almond freshness, while a few years bottle age has brought out savoury elements.	£68
56	Pommard Les Perrières, Domaine Sébastien Magnien Burgundy, France Delicious Chablis offering pure forest fruit flavours with delicate spice and mineral complexities.	£95
57	Ridge Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2017 California, USA Aromas of cassis, blueberry, cola, licorice, and sweet oak. Ripe blackberry fruit entry, full bodied, rich textures, exotic spice roasted coffee, and toasted oak aftertaste. Complex, long, sensuous finish.	£125

The rich oily texture fills the mouth, but a cleansing and bright acidity stops this becoming cloying.	£6	£25
68	Muscat de Beumes de Venise, Paporotier 2017 Rhône, France Notes of ripe pears and tropical litchis gives way to appealing stone fruit flavours with just a touch of beeswax. The palate is fresh and fruity, with a citrusy note cutting through the sweetness, ensuring a lengthy and bright finish.	£6	£25
69	Finca Antigua Moscatel Naturalmente Dulce 2019 Castilla-La Mancha, Spain (Ve) A stunning mixture of concentration and freshness, tingling with orangey acidity and floral, grapey aromas, then direct, powerful and surprisingly sweet on the palate. A tour de force!	£6	£28
70	La Fleur d'Or, Sauternes 2017 Bordeaux, France (Ve) An immediately inviting nose, combining apricot fruit, creamy patisserie notes and a certain citrus brightness, leads to a sweet yet beautifully balanced palate. Luscious but never cloying.	£7.50	£35
71	Angelorum Recioto della Valpolicella, Masi 2016 Veneto, Italy (Ve) A decadent nose of kirsch-soaked cherries leads to a rich, complex palate that is full of fruit, relatively sweet, yet balanced by a persistent freshness that cleanses the mouth ready for the inevitable next sip.	£7.50	£45
72	LBV Port, Quinta do Crasto Douro, Portugal (Ve) Velvety mouthfeel from a trellis supporting wild blackberries and other wild fruit, while a waft of cacao supplies welcome savouriness and balance.	£6	
73	LBV, Croft Douro, Portugal (Ve) From the oldest Port house still in operation, the LBV offers an opulent and seductive nose of mocha, rose, and liquorice. Sumptuous coulis of blackcurrant awaits on the richly textured palate merging with subtle herbal and balsamic notes and a velvety texture.	£6
