15. PINOT GRIGIO – PAPANUDA, CRAMELE RECAS, ROMANIA 22.00
Such a revelation, a gem from Romania. Whilst bold in texture a wine displaying crisp & fresh citrus fruit flavours together with uplifting minerality.
16. DART VALLEY RESERVE – SHARPHAM, TOTNES, DEVON 36.50
From the banks of the River Dart near Totnes, deliciously fragrant & uplifting on both the bouquet & palate, off dry & not too weighty.
17. VIOGNIER, LES ARGELIERES, CEZABAN, FRANCE 26.00
Cracking example of d French Viognier, peaches, apricots, a twist of lemon & yet long & persistent on the finish.
18. ICARE CHARDONNAY, COTES DU THONGUE, FRANCE 29.00
So reminiscent of a clean wood influenced smart Burgundy, yet half the price! Oak aged, smokey yet not overwhelming.
19. CHABLIS, DOMAINE ALBERT BICHOT, BURGUNDY, FRANCE 41.00
A very refined and classic Chablis with tight citrus fruit & mineral overtones. The finish is crisp yet surprisingly long & lingering.
20. BASA RUEDA BLANCO, RUEDA, SPAIN 26.00
One of the up & coming Whites from Spain – expressive perfumed fruit characteristics. A mix of Verdejo~Viura & a small amount of Sauvignon Blanc. Zippy and aromatic with a twist of lemon
21. MACON PRISSE 'LES CLOCHETTES', BURGUNDY, FRANCE 37.00
Uncomplicated, unwooded classic White Burgundy delivering weighty broad fruit with honey & lemon & a touch of minerality. A favourite at the Orange Tree.
22. DR. LOOSEN ESTATE RIESLING, MOSEL, GERMANY 33.50
From Germany's charismatic 'Winemaker of the Year' Ernst Loosen. This delicious fruity style of Riesling has green apple & floral notes, with sweet & sour appeal.
23. GAVI DI GAVI, TENUTA MANENTI, PIEDMONT, ITALY 39.00
A wonderfully vibrant dry, fresh & fruity Italian made from hand-picked Cortese grapes that delivers an abundance of fruit & a long pleasing finish.
24. GEWÜRZTRAMINER, DOPFF & IRION, ALSACE 34.00
Rose petal, turkish delight, hints of ginger & spice, not too dry. Recommended with smoked fish & spicy dishes.

25. CURRABRIDGE CHARDONNAY, SOUTH EAST AUSTRALIA 25.50
A delicious & uplifting mix of tropical fruits with the gentlest hint of oak, whilst very Australian, this wine shows welcome restraint & elegance.
26. FAIRFIELDS SAUVIGNON BLANC, MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND 30.00
The very epitome of a New World Sauvignon Blanc, with vibrant gooseberry & asparagus notes climaxing with fantastic finishing acidity.
27. DOMAINE ROAD PINOT GRIS, CENTRAL OTAGO, NEW ZEALAND 38.00
A great palate teaser ~ Off dry and slightly herbaceous with notes of almonds and Pear ~ Great acidity.
28. FREEDOM CROSS CHENIN BLANC, FRANSCHHOEK, SOUTH AFRICA 25.00
Full, ripe & a clean off-dry finish. Pear drops ~ Crunchy apple.

29. BLANC DE MER, BOUCHARD FINLAYSON, WALKER BAY, SOUTH AFRICA 39.50
An intriguing combination of Riesling, Viognier, Chardonnay and a little Chenin Blanc. The result being racy, tropical fruit overtones with unmistakable aromatic uplifting acidity.
30. ALBARIÑO – BERNON, RIAS BAIXAS, GALICIA, SPAIN 34.00
Oozing an abundance of floral & fragrant notes with a delicate sweetness & lasting fruit, clean, fresh & tangy on the finish.
31. SANCERRE – DOMAINE DAULNY, LOIRE VALLEY, FRANCE 42.00
Classic Sancerre displaying extreme elegance with tight almost grassy perfumed nuances & a typical minerality on the finish.
32. POUILLY FUISSE, VIEILLES VIGNES, DOMAINE GONON, BURGUNDY, FRANCE 46.00
Our flagship Burgundy, terrific, enticing bouquet, the palate displaying nuances of melon, toast & vanilla overtones, yet this classic Southern White Burgundy climaxes with a pleasing citrus kick.

33. COTES DU RHONE VILLAGES, MASSIF D'UCHAUX, ARBOUSE, RHONE VALLEY, FRANCE 26.00
A classic Rhone blend of Grenache, Syrah & Carignan. Warm, spicy & peppery with ripe bramble fruit & a remarkable depth of flavour. Proper Rhone.
34. CHÂTEAU MALBAT, BORDEAUX, FRANCE 25.50
Totally dependable gentle Claret a blend of 95% Merlot & 5% Cabernet Sauvignon, fruity, soft & generous.
35. MONTE ARAYA SEMI CRIANZA, BODEGAS EL MEDIEVO, RIOJA, SPAIN 25.00
Soft & silky texture, good depth with flavours of soft dark berry fruit, ripe cherries with spicy, savoury notes, enhanced by rounded vanilla oak.
36. TERRA D'ALTER TINTO, ALTO ALENTEJO, PORTUGAL 27.00
Ripe red fruit & plums on the bouquet, spicy culinary nuances climaxing with toasty oak & a smooth finish. Made by Aussie wine Guru, Peter Bright.
37. VINA COLLADO GARNACHA-SYRAH, CAMPO DE BORJA, SPAIN 24.50
This wine is alive with ripe youthful rich perfumed Garnacha (Grenache) fruit & has a wonderful concentration & pleasing spicy bite. Made 40 miles south east of Rioja.
38. RESERVE LA ROCA, COTES DU ROUSSILLON, FRANCE 26.00
A real gem from Southern France, displaying juicy hedgerow fruit & enhanced by a kiss of pepper and spice & a touch of oak.
39. CHIANTI DUCA DI SARAGNANO, TUSCANY, ITALY 29.00
Our everyday Chianti. Brooding Sangiovese fruit, dark morello cherry, distinctive savoury notes & a welcome Mediterranean kiss of spice. Great with cheese & pasta dishes.
40. PRIMITIVO PASSITIVO, PUGLIA, ITALY 31.00
From the very heel of Italy. Voluptuous yet well rounded Red with dried fruit notes. The Primitivo grape is known to many as the Zinfandel.
41. KARL JOHNER PINOT NOIR KAISERSTUHL, BADEN, GERMANY 39.00
With more Pinot Noir grown in Germany than Burgundy it is little surprise that they do produce exceptional wines such as this one... A Gem.

42. HALLMARK GRENACHE, MCLAREN VALE, AUSTRALIA 34.00
Punchy, deep and dramatic. Perfumed and generous damson and spicy note made by well-respected producer Simon Hallet.
43. LADERA VERDE CABERNET SAUVIGNON, CENTRAL VALLEY, CHILE 22.00
Deep bright red with violet hues. An aromatic intensity with red cherry, blackberry & raspberry jam, accented by notes of toast, mint & chocolate.
44. FREEDOM CROSS PINOTAGE, FRANSCHHOEK, SOUTH AFRICA 26.00
The grape of the Cape. Ripe cherry, sappy eucalyptus, juicy hints of plum and culinary spice.
45. BROOKFORD SHIRAZ-CABERNET, SOUTH AUSTRALIA 23.00
Rich & full flavoured packed with dark berry aromas, vanilla oak & a hint of stewed plums. Flavours of dried fruits, cassis & mocha on the palate.
46. GOUGUENHEIM MALBEC, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA 29.50
Very much the in grape, & few do it better. Perfumed, deep & dark fruit, ultra-soft & satisfying.
47. TOPUKU PINOT NOIR, MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND 34.00
Silky & spicy with dark berry, plum & clove, with dark cherry, liquorice & vanilla, notes of subtle oak & a mouth filling texture.
48. CARMENERE RESERVA, CASA SILVA, COLCHAGUA, VALLEY, CHILE 32.00
Award winning wine, Carmenere gets no better than this. Dark, robust with eucalyptus overtones & a touch of cassis.

49. FLEURIE LA CAVE DU CHATEAU DE CHENAS, BEAUJOLAIS, FRANCE 37.00
The very epitome of the Cru Beaujolais – heaps of vibrant fruit, lively mid palate & lingering.
50. CHATEAU CISSAC, CRU BOURGEOIS, HAUT MEDOC, FRANCE 47.50
A full flavoured reliable robust & balanced Cru Bourgeois showing classic left-bank Bordelaise overtones of cedar & tobacco, black fruits, ripe cherries, vanilla & cinnamon spices to warm the palate.
51. CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE, TELEGRAMME, RHONE VALLEY, FRANCE 65.00
The second wine of Domaine Vieux Télégraphe. 80% Grenache, 10% Syrah, 6% Mourvedre & 4% Cinsault. Very approachable with full fruit, deliciously round with a touch of minerality.
52. SAVIGNY LES BEAUNE, DOMAINE JEAN JACQUES GIRARD, BURGUNDY, FRANCE 56.00
A wine rightfully reputed for maturing early yet displaying bold full & mouth filling Pinot Noir. Succulent plums & slight savoury notes.
